Be a Friend

A new intergenerational "Friend" ministry is starting to connect adults in our congregation with children and youth. Studies indicate that children and youth who had positive adult influences—in addition to parents—are more likely to be healthy adults. Similar research indicates that the "stickiness" of faith—whether faith sticks from childhood into adulthood—is also influenced by having positive influences from other adults *in the church*.

Parents—you will be learning more about this ministry in the coming months and will be asked if you want your child to participate.

Adults—you will be asked to volunteer to be a Friend. Adult Friends will extend the love of Christ and care of the Church by being supportive of their young Friend. This may include greeting them at worship, attending music or sporting events or other extracurricular events, sending birthday cards, making a phone call or sending a text message occasionally to say hello, inquiring to learn more about how they're doing in school, etc. Being a Friend will certainly include praying for your friend.

Children and Youth—Talk to your parents about being a Friend. You will also be asked to care about and pray for your adult Friend too.

Shared Blessings Meals

THANK YOU to all who helped with Shared Blessings in 2016. We appreciate your help and hope you experienced the blessing of serving others in our community. It's our prayer that "community" happens both in the dining area **and** the kitchen!

January will begin the 8th year! The meals will continue to be served from 11:00 a.m. to Noon on the second, fourth, and fifth Saturdays each month.

We have several community groups who help regularly with Shared Blessings meals. When community groups serve the meals, we need one person from our church to serve as a "coordinator" or "host" for the meal. The "coordinator" or "host" helps groups navigate the kitchen, answers questions and gives guidance for meal preparation and clean-up. If that task sounds overwhelming, ask a friend to do it with you. (Those who are experienced will also be happy to provide training.)

The sign-up sheets for 2017 are located in the Gathering Place. Please consider volunteering – it's a great way to meet new friends or invite a group of friends, committee/SS class/Circle/GIG or another small group sign up for a meal or two.

Many volunteer opportunities are available. If you are interested in helping cook or with meal preparation, we do some food prep ahead of time and the rest during the early (9:00-11:00) shift. If you are interested in serving, cleanup, and interacting with those who come to Shared Blessings, sign up for the late (11:00-1:00) shift. We also need people to drive the bus, deliver meals to "homebound" folks, and provide "hospitality or friendship" by simply eating and talking with our guests. Sign up now in the Gathering Place or contact Heather Strefling, Renee Mente (886-3239; keegankoltonkenzie@msn.com) or the church office.

Renee Mente will continue to be available and help you plan your meal as needed. She does a great job coordinating the menus with the current inventory.

Backpack Buddies

Carroll Mitchell Scholarships

Carroll Mitchell endowed scholarships for members and constituents of the Tipton United Methodist Church. 
