OFFERTORY THOUGHT

Luke describes individuals casting lots after Jesus says, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Casting lots was a method used to foretell the future or determine something by chance. In Old Testament stories, priests threw painted dice or bones on the ground – cast lots - to determine which goat was to be sacrificed to the Lord and which goat would serve as the "scapegoat," carrying upon its back all the sins of the children of Israel. The scapegoat was sent off into the wilderness alone. So as the soldiers cast lots near the cross, Jesus took on both roles of the Old Testament: as the sacrifice and as the one who carried our sins upon his back.


