

A Word From Pastor Melody

Hello Church,

Today I would like to talk to you about our Youth Leadership Challenge. When I arrived in Tipton I had the wonderful opportunity to sit down with many of you in small groups and talk about what you value and where you would like me to focus my energy. An easy 95% said, **YOUTH!**
